- Review service footage with Video Director for training purposes
- Operate camera for special events (as requested/scheduled)

## Details

### **Operate camera for Scheduled Sunday Worship Experiences**

- Following the direction of the video director, capture the musical and speaking portions of the weekend service
- Maintain attention throughout the service

### **Review service footage with Video Director for training purposes**

- When possible, after a service, review the footage with the director to improve timing, composition and transitions of shots

### **Operate camera for special events**

- Based on availability, capture special events such as Good Friday, Christmas Production or Christmas Eve
